

LAMINATE FLOORING CARE GUIDE



Sweep & Vacuum

Sweep with a soft brush or vacuum with a hard floor attachment (no beater bar) to remove grit that can scratch the wear layer.

Mopping

When cleaning, use a slightly damp cloth rather than a wet mop. Excessive moisture can seep in to the seams of laminate flooring, leading to swelling or warping. It's important to avoid using steam cleaners or soaking the floor.



Furniture



Place protective pads under furniture. Use doormats at entrances (non-rubber backed) to reduce dirt and grit. In busy areas, consider placing rugs or runners with anti-slip backing.

Spills

Wipe up spills immediately. Standing liquid can cause damage overtime. Dry the area after spill occurs. Avoid liquid seeping through joints.



Avoid Chemicals



Do not use bleach, ammonia, or abrasive powders. Steam mops are not recommended, as excessive heat and moisture can damage the floors.
